

Block of the Month  
January 2021  
Argyle Pride - National Argyle Day Jan 8th

Select a piece of argyle fabric, two matching solids.

Cut the following:

- Base Argyle - (4) 2 ½" squares  
                   (4) 3" squares cut diagonally for triangles
- Solid #1 - (2) 2 ½" squares  
             (2) 3" squares cut diagonally for triangles
- Solid #2 - (2) 2 ½" squares  
             (2) 3" squares cut diagonally for triangles



Sew (1) argyle triangle to (1) Solid #1 triangle. Repeat until all 4 are sewn. Press flat.



Sew (1) argyle triangle to (1) Solid #2 triangle. Repeat until all 4 are sewn. Press flat.



Sew (1) 2 ½" argyle square to (1) Argyle/Solid #1 square. Solid on the left, triangles on the right. Press flat and repeat.

Sew (1) 2 ½" Solid #1 square to (1) Argyle/Solid #1 square. Triangles on the left, solid #1 on the right. Press flat and repeat.

From previous steps, take one of each and sew together. Repeat and press flat. This should leave you with 4 squares. Repeat for Solid #2.



Sew (1) square with the argyle on the top left and Solid #1 print to (1) square with the argyle on the bottom left and Solid #2 print. Press flat.

Sew (1) square with the argyle on the top right and Solid #2 print to (1) square with the argyle on the bottom right and Solid #1 print. Press flat.

Sew the top rectangles together, making sure the argyle squares are in the corners. Press flat. Should make a 8 /12" block.

\*Options - you can alternate with a third or fourth solid color from the argyle into the blocks or use the colors for sashing between the blocks.
