





Block of the Month

May 2021

The Race is On! - National Mother Goose Day May 1st

*Choose 3 colors (solid, polka dot or print) with a matching stripes material - These will be your racing colors!*

<p>Cut your "Racing Geese" for each color. (3) Color - 2" x 3.5" rectangle (6) Base - 2" square (2) Base - 2" x 1.5" rectangle</p>	<p>Cut your "Racing Stripes" for each goose. (1) - Stripe Color - 2" x 11" rectangle (2) - Base - 1" x 11" rectangle</p>
<p>Place a 2" base square at one end of your color rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square, as shown. Sew on the marked line and trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle.</p>	
<p>Repeat at the remaining end of the rectangle.  Make 3 of your racing geese for each color.</p>	
<p>Next, connect the racing geese in a row of the same color with the base 2" x 1.5" pieces. Make sure the middle is flipped!!!  You should have 3 rows of racing geese in different colors.</p>	
<p>Now - put your racing stripes together for each geese, base to stripe to base.  **NOTE: The stripe piece will not look this wide when it is sewn together.</p>	
<p>Finally, let's race some geese! Stack your geese in the order of your preference.  Option: You can add a border around the edge of each block or you can extend this block by making longer rows/more columns.  **NOTE: The stripe piece will not look that large in between.</p>
