

San Joaquin Valley Quilters' Guild July for August Block of the Month - *Rainbow Fish*

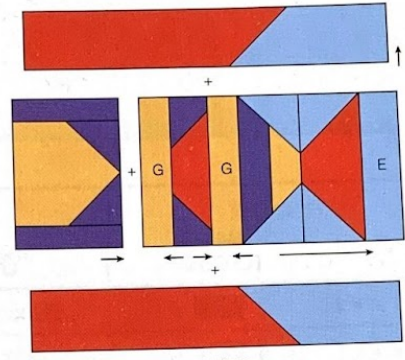
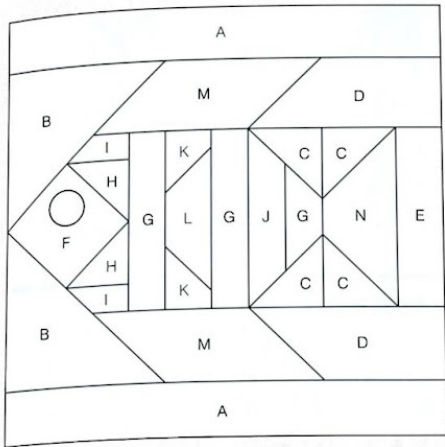
Tropical fish come in many vibrant colors. Use your imagination and scraps from your stash to create a beautiful Rainbow Fish.



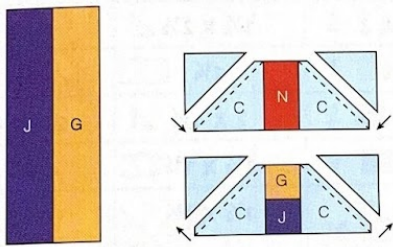
This block was designed by Cindy Mundy Cochran.

Lay out all pieces before you begin sewing to make sure your directional fabrics end up the way you want them to. Sew the eye on your fish when you complete the block. The finished block should measure 12" to 12 ½" square. Please attach a 1" framing border in your background fabric all around the block to give us room to trim if necessary when we assemble the donation quilt. The framing border is not shown here.

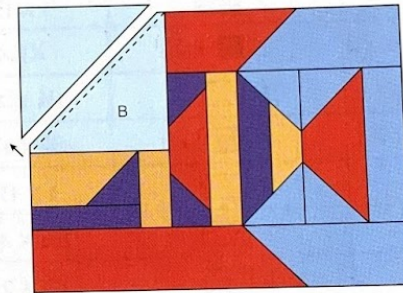
