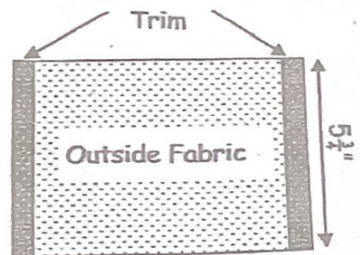


Tissue Keeper

For Outside: Cut one rectangle $5\frac{3}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$.
For Lining/Trim: Cut one rectangle $5\frac{3}{4}'' \times 7\frac{3}{4}''$.

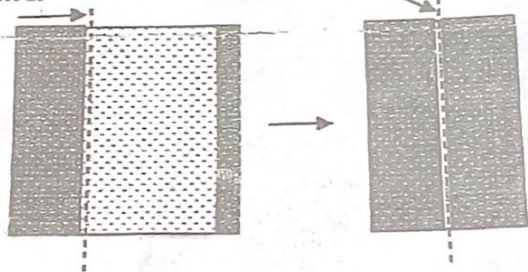
With right sides together and using a $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam allowance, sew outside and lining pieces together on each $5\frac{3}{4}''$ side. (Lining fabric is longer than outside fabric.) This will create a tube. Turn right sides out. With outside fabric on top, press seams toward the lining fabric so that approximately $\frac{1}{4}''$ of lining fabric shows on each side. This creates the trim.



With outside fabric still on top, fold in half, trim to trim, and crease. Now fold each side in so that trims meet at the crease. Pin as needed.

Fold both sides toward center crease.

Crease



Using a $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam allowance and back stitching at start and finish, sew both ends (raw edges).



Turn right sides out to finish.
