Bow Tie Instructions

Fabric Cutting Instructions

Background (Shirt Color): A - Cut 2 pieces 5" X 5" Bow Tie: B - Cut 2 pieces 5" X 5" C - Cut 2 pieces 2.75" X 2.75"

Border (WHITE): D - Cut 2 pieces 2" X 9.5" E - Cut 2 pieces 2" X 12.5"






Assembly and Sewing Instructions

Sew with an accurate quarter inch seam allowance.

- 1. Draw a line from one corner to the opposite corner on the wrong side of piece C.
- 2. Align a marked piece C, right sides together, with one corner of piece A.
- 3. Sew a seam directly on the marked line. Trim away excess fabric from both layers 1/4 inch past the seam line.
- 4. Press the seam allowance towards the large square.
- 5. Repeat the steps above for a second square.
- 6. Arrange the pieced units and two bow tie squares into two rows as shown. Sew components of each row together and press seam allowances towards the large bow tie square.
- 7. Sew the two rows together and press.
- 8. Add border pieces D to top and bottom of square and then add pieces E to both sides.



Finished block will be 12.5" square. Please do not trim.
