PUSS IN A CORNER - October 2023

Fabric Needed:

Red, White, and Blue (Prewash fabrics to avoid colors bleeding in the finished quilt)

Fabric Cuts:

One $4\,\%$ " center square (either red or blue) Four $2\,\%$ " squares (in the opposite color from the center square) Four $2\,\%$ " X $4\,\%$ " rectangles (white)



Sewing Steps

- 1. Sew two corner squares to each side of two white rectangles using a coordinated thread color and $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Iron the seam allowances in the same direction.
- 2. Sew two white rectangles to the side of the center fabric square. Iron seams in the opposite direction from above.
- 3. Sew the three rows together.

Please do not trim your completed block.
