## PUSS IN A CORNER - October 2023

Fabric Needed:
Red, White, and Blue
(Prewash fabrics to avoid colors bleeding in the finished quilt)
Fabric Cuts:
One $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center square (either red or blue)
Four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (in the opposite color from the center square)
Four $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ X $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (white)


Sewing Steps

1. Sew two corner squares to each side of two white rectangles using a coordinated thread color and $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Iron the seam allowances in the same direction.
2. Sew two white rectangles to the side of the center fabric square. Iron seams in the opposite direction from above.
3. Sew the three rows together.

Please do not trim your completed block.
