CARD TRICK - May 2024

Fabric Needed: 4 colors, 1 white (if using red, please prewash)

Fabric Cuts:

For each color:

One 2 1/2" square

One 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle

For white:


Two 3" squares (cut on the diagonal)

Two 3 ½" squares (cut on the diagonal)



Sewing Steps:


- 1. Take the four 2 ½" squares (one of each color) and sew them into a four patch.
- Lay out the colored rectangles and background triangles as shown in the diagram to get a clearer idea of how the pieces will be assembled.



- 3. Using a ¼" seam
 - A. Sew a rectangle to the 4-patch, lining it up with the matching square. The matching square should be on the *left* end of the rectangle as shown.
 - B. Repeat step A with the rectangle on the opposite side.



- C. Sew the smaller triangles to the remaining rectangles.
- D. Line them up with the matching squares on the 4-patch as in step 3A.



E. Finally, sew the larger triangles to the colored rectangles to achieve the block shown in the diagram and image above. Finished Block Size = $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Please do not trim.
