## CARD TRICK - May 2024

Fabric Needed: 4 colors, 1 white (if using red, please prewash)

## Fabric Cuts:

For each color:
One $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
One $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
For white:
Two 3" squares (cut on the diagonal)


Two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (cut on the diagonal)

## Sewing Steps:

1. Take the four $21 / 2$ " squares (one of each color) and sew them into a four patch.
2. Lay out the colored rectangles and background triangles as shown in the diagram to get a clearer idea of how the pieces will be assembled.

3. Using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam -
A. Sew a rectangle to the 4-patch, lining it up with the matching square. The matching square should be on the left end of the rectangle as shown.
B. Repeat step A with the rectangle on the opposite side.

C. Sew the smaller triangles to the remaining rectangles.
D. Line them up with the matching squares on the 4-patch as in step 3A.

E. Finally, sew the larger triangles to the colored rectangles to achieve the block shown in the diagram and image above. Finished Block Size $=81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Please do not trim.
