MONKEY WRENCH BLOCK – August 2024

Fabric Needed:

Two contrasting colors, one Light and one Dark from the same color family. If using RED, please prewash.

Fabric Cuts:

Two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of each color


Two 3 ¾" squares of each color, cut on the diagonal

Two 6 1/2" squares of each color, cut on the diagonal

Sewing Steps:

1. Sew a 4-patch using the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares and alternating the colors.





- Sew two of the 3 ¾" diagonal cuts to opposite sides of the 4-patch. For example, the two dark triangles in the diagram here.
- 3. Sew the other two 3 ¾" diagonal cuts to the remaining sides of the 4-patch. For example, the light colored triangles in the diagram here.
- Sew two of the 6 ½" diagonal cuts to opposite sides of the unit created in step 3. Follow this illustration to create the curve.
- 5. Sew the two remaining 6 ½" diagonal cuts to the two remaining sides.

Finished Block Size - 8 ½" X 8 ½" Please do not trim.
