

Magic Block

This block was demonstrated on Jeremy Swaim's Tipsy Tuesday (7/23/24) post

To make 2 blocks:

- Cut 2 ½" strips of:
- Light/background: cut 2 WOF
- Medium: cut 2 WOF
- Dark/focus fabric: cut 1 WOF

Press seams all in one direction. You will sub cut 10 ½" blocks. Take care to only just trim off the salvage before cutting the blocks.

Arrangement:



Arrangement variation of strip set: cut 2 of dark/focus fabric, and 1 of medium. Switch their places in the arrangement

Note: I wanted to use a Jelly Roll for this project, but it may not give you the repeats needed for additional strip sets for more blocks. You could use a jelly roll if you wanted scrappy and cut the background from yardage.

The strip set should measure 10½" in width and you are cutting 10½" blocks from that. Check your ¼" seam allowance before you begin sewing the strip set. You need to be accurate for your strip set to come out at 10½" wide.

Then the blocks are cut on the two diagonals. Two of the triangles are sewn together to create the blocks, one I call Tree Trunks and the other I called Surfboard. You will use one tree trunk and one surfboard for your new blocks. Sets of four blocks are assembled to make a large block.


The blocks can be arranged in different ways as shown in the photo below and your fabric selection and placement will result in a variety of designs. Jeremy suggested using holiday fabrics and demonstrated the arrangement (in blue) where the darker fabrics are on the outer edges of the strip set and a coordinating floral is in the center. The background is white or a tone on tone.

For each strip set (Four Blocks)

3 fabrics:

- -Main (2 Strips)
- -Accent (1 Strip)
- -Background (2 Strips)


Subcut strip set by 10 1/2" then cut blocks corner to corner both ways




Cut corner to corner. Combine 2 8 25 surfloord All seams nest except for, just clip in the
