## Autumn Leaf – November 2024

Fabric Needed: Fall leaf colors

Off white or muslin (background)


Fabric Cuts:

Leaf Print Two 5" squares

Four 4 1/2" squares

Off White One 4 1/2" square

Two 4" squares Two 5" squares



## Sewing Steps:

- 1. Make 4 half square triangles with 5" leaf & 5" background fabrics:
  - a) Draw or press a diagonal line on back of each 5" background square. Place on top of 5" leaf print with right sides together.
  - b) Sew 1/4" on either side of drawn line. Cut apart on diagonal line; press to the leaf print. Trim to 4 1/2".
- 2. Make one stem block using magic corners: See diagram.
  - a) Draw or press a diagonal line on back of each 4" background square. Place one of these on one corner of one 4 1/2" leaf square.
  - b) Sew ON THE LINE. Trim corner leaving 1/4" allowance. Press to the leaf print.
  - c) Repeat steps a) and b) on opposite corner. Trim to 4 1/2" if needed.
  - 3. Lay out as pictured with remaining squares. Sew together as a 9 patch.

Your block, (including outside seam allowances) should measure 12 1/2". Please do not trim.
